

RESOLUTION 02-15

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RIO ALTO WATER DISTRICT IN SUPPORT OF TEHAMA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT (TCFCWCD) FORMING AND ACTING AS THE GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY (GSA) THAT COVERS ALL OF THE GROUNDWATER BASINS WITHIN TEHAMA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2014, the Governor of California signed SB1168, AB1168, AB1730, and SB1319 into law, enacting the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA); and

WHEREAS, SGMA became effective January 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, SGMA requires regions to form a Groundwater Management Agency(GSA) by June 30, 2017 and those agencies to develop a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) which includes measureable objectives and milestones that will assist the County in achieving sustainability within 20 years of the GSP adoption; and

WHEREAS, Tehama County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (TCFCWCD) has requested support in their efforts to form and act as the GSA that covers all of the groundwater basins within Tehama County; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Rio Alto Water District acknowledge that the TCFCWCD was instrumental in developing a Groundwater Management Plan in compliance with AB3030 and as such are the most likely candidate to form and act as the GSA for the groundwater basins within Tehama County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Rio Alto Water District are in support of the TCFCWCD forming and acting as the GSA for the groundwater basins within Tehama County.


