RESOLUTION 03-16 OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RIO ALTO WATER DISTRICT RATIFYING RESOLUTION 01-15 MANDATORY EMERGENCY WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES.

WHEREAS, Executive Order B-37-16 signed by the Governor on May 9, 2016 ordered the State Water Board to adjust emergency water conservation regulations through January 2017; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2016 the State Water Board adopted a statewide conservation approach replacing the prior percentage reduction based water conservation standards with a localized "stress test" approach that mandates urban water suppliers to ensure at least a 3 year supply of water to their customers under drought conditions; and

WHEREAS, Water agencies that would face shortages under 3 additional dry years are required to meet a conservation standard equal to the amount of shortage; and


WHEREAS, Rio Alto Water District is a Non-Urban Water Supplier with an adequate supply of water for three continued years of drought, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Directors of Rio Alto Water District suspends the limitation on irrigation watering days until January 1, 2017. Rio Alto Water District will follow the state regulations as they are promulgated.
