Billing Updates: New Metered billings for the period 11/3/24 through 01/03/25 were mailed out on January 3, 2025 and are due by February 10, 2025 to avoid delinquent charges. In accordance with SB998, **unpaid accounts for the billing period 9/3/24 through 11/3/24** will be subject to **24 Hour Notices on February 10, 2025**, and shutoffs on **February 11, 2025**. Availability lot billings were mailed out on 12/31/24 and are due by February 6, 2025, to avoid delinquent charges. Payments can be made by check or cash, and credit card payments can be made on our website at www.RAWD.org. Customers can also sign up for auto draft payments by completing the form found on our website or at the District office. This service is free and will ensure payment is received before delinquent charges are assessed.

Rate Increases: Year two of the 5-Year Rate Increases became effective January 3, 2025, in accordance with Resolution 01-24 as follows:

Drought: The new water year began October 1, 2024. As of January 19, 2025, the new season to date totals compared with the previous two years as follows:

The beginning of this water year started to be a very good year, but a dry January has dampened the enthusiasm. According to the snow report taken on January 17th, the statewide average was 81% of normal compared to the previous month where it was reported at 108% of the statewide average. The snowpack provides 30% of the annual water to the state.
