Payments can be made by check or cash, and credit card payments can be made on our website at [www.RAWD.org](http://www.RAWD.org). Be advised that when you go through your bank and use bill-pay, they deduct it from your account and a third party issues checks which are mailed to us. That third party often holds on to those checks until they have enough to warrant sending through the mail. **The check that they issue to Rio Alto can take over 10 days to be received by the District. Please allow adequate time to avoid a delinquent charge.** Customers can also sign up for auto draft payments by completing the form found on our website or at the District office. This service is free and will ensure payment is received before delinquent charges are assessed.

## Water Conditions:

The Water Year ended on September 30<sup>th</sup> and compares with the last two water years as follows:

Shasta Dam is currently releasing 5,509cfs.

**Outdoor Irrigation:** Fall is here and now is the time to either reduce or shut off your outdoor irrigation systems. This will save on water usage and save you money! Remember, it is still state law that no outdoor watering is to occur within 48 hours of significant rain event. There is much uncertainty with future water regulations in the state of California, so if you are considering installing drought landscape, now is the time.

**Repairs/Maintenance:** The major repairs on Dinghy will begin shortly. Please have respect for the workers in the road, slow down and follow traffic control instructions.
