## RIO ALTO WATER SYSTEM:

Rio Alto Water District's water system consists of four production wells and four storage tanks. There are two pressure zones in the water system.

The four production wells can produce a total of 2900 gallons per minute. All water is pumped to our two large tanks in the upper pressure zone. These tanks, totaling 1.85 million gallons, feed the entire upper pressure zone which includes the areas surrounding Lake California Drive and River View Drive. They also feed two smaller tanks totaling 300,000 gallons that, in turn feed the lower pressure zone surrounding the lake.

The water system is routinely monitored for bacteriological contamination and each of the four wells is tested for chemical constituents as required by the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

The State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water requires that we prepare and publish a Consumer Confidence Report annually.
